### **PFLAG Salisbury, Inc. Receives \$5,000 “A Community Thrives” Grant From USA TODAY NETWORK and The Gannett Foundation**

*PFLAG Salisbury, Inc. will receive a \$5,000 Local Operating Grant for LGBTQ+ Youth Programming.*

October 7, 2021 (Salisbury, MD) – PFLAG Salisbury, Inc. was announced a grant recipient of *A Community Thrives*, a grantmaking and crowd-funding program from the USA TODAY NETWORK and a part of the Gannett Foundation, today. PFLAG Salisbury, Inc. will receive a \$5,000 Local Operating Grant for LGBTQ+ Youth Programming, in partnership with Faith Lutheran Church of Salisbury.

*A Community Thrives* supports non-profit organizations with projects focused on community building and has helped to contribute more than \$17 million since 2017. This year, *A Community Thrives* engaged participants in 45 states. *PFLAG Salisbury, Inc.* was named one of 2 winners in the State of Maryland.

PFLAG Salisbury, Inc.’s mission is to support LGBTQ+ people and their allies, increase the visibility of the LGBTQ+ community, educate the local community on practices that create affirming environments for LGBTQ+ people, and to work with organizations and government to create policies and procedures that support and affirm LGBTQ+ people. The *A Community Thrives* grant will support a years’ worth of youth programming, including weekly online meet-ups and monthly in-person activities for LGBTQ+ youth in our local community, ages 12-18. Programming is offered in conjunction with one of our faith partners, Faith Lutheran Church of Salisbury.

Executive Director, Mark DeLancey, says “it is important that we serve our local LGBTQ+ youth, working to create opportunities for them to connect with each other, develop friendships, and serve as sources of support for one another. We are very excited that, with funding from an *A Community Thrives* Local Operating Grant, we are able to both continue our existing programming, and expand it to serve more youth here locally. Thank you to our partner, Faith Lutheran Church of Salisbury, for assisting us in securing this grant.”
