Salisbury PFLAG is a completely volunteer run organization whose success is dependent on the hard work and support of our members and associated community organizations. For the second year, it is our pleasure to recognize those in the community who have gone above and beyond in their support of our organization. While social distancing prevents us from having a formal ceremony, we are proud to announce and acknowledge our award recipients and their efforts in helping Salisbury PFLAG continue to ignite positive change in the community.

The Volunteer Appreciation Award recognizes those individuals who have contributed outstanding service to Salisbury's PFLAG chapter by embodying the finest spirit of volunteerism. For 2020, our Volunteer Appreciation Award recipients are Jessica Vooris, Alison Vooris, and Arlette Bright. These three individuals have all contributed significantly to the development and enhancement of Salisbury PFLAG. Jessica Vooris and Alison Vooris were recognized for their commitment to facilitating our online weekly youth group; Arlette Bright was recognized for her assistance in updating our Articles of Incorporation and willingness to serve as our Resident Agent.

The Community Partner Award is given annually to one, or more, organizations who are not only doing great work in the community, but have also undertaken additional efforts in partnering with Salisbury PFLAG to further our work to uplift LGBTQ+ people in the region.
